Make Space Festival, York — June 2026

Welcome to the Make Space Festival.

Across two weekends in June, York's parks will come alive with a programme of free events and activities designed especially for teenage girls. The festival is all about creating space to try new things, meet new people, build confidence and have fun.

Saturday 13 & Sunday 14 June - Rowntree Park

Saturday 20 & Sunday 21 June - Homestead Park

The programme includes a wide mix of activities, from sports and movement sessions to arts, crafts, dance, photography, performing arts, nature connection, zine making, music, printing and more.

Events are primarily for girls aged 10 to 18, with some suitable for ages 8 and up. While many sessions are free and bookable, there will also be some drop in activities and stalls running throughout the day, so you can come along, spend time with friends and get involved at your own pace.

This is a festival in the loosest sense. It is not a big crowded event, it's more a collection of activities - it is a relaxed, welcoming space where you can hang out, explore and take part in whatever feels right for you. Bring a picnic or use one of the park cafes and stick around for a while.

Inside this programme you will find an overview of events along with detailed listings to help you plan your visit. Spaces are limited on sessions, so please only book onto events if you know you can attend. Your support with this is appreciated.

Why do we need to make space for girls in parks?

The Make Space York project began in 2021 in Rowntree Park. It focuses on addressing a clear and consistent issue: girls use parks far less than boys as they enter their teenage years.

This matters. Parks play an important role in physical health, mental wellbeing and independence. They should feel welcoming to everyone, including teenage girls.

Many park spaces are not intentionally designed to exclude girls, but in practice they often do. Facilities aimed at teenagers tend to focus on sport and skill based activities such as skateparks, multi use games areas, basketball courts and bike tracks. While these spaces are open to everyone, research shows that around 90% of users are boys and men. Therefore facilities aren't gendered, patterns of use are.

We should address the barriers and encourage those who want to use the spaces to do so, but it's also about recognising that not all teenagers want the same things, and that girls' voices are often missing when parks are designed or improved.

For teenagers, *play* is still important. However many teenagers feel they are too old to be in play parks as they fear disapproval from parents/carers or the equipment is simply too small for them.

Teenage girls consistently tell us they want places where they can:

- be active without pressure or competition
- spend time with friends
- feel comfortable, visible and welcome

This often includes simple but thoughtful features such as swings, climbing structures, informal activity equipment and plenty of places to sit and gather.

Parks are one of the few free public spaces where young people can explore independence, connect with others and simply be. When we design with teenage girls in mind, many other groups benefit too.

If girls do not feel welcome in parks, what does that say about their place in public life?



The Project in York

Make Space York was founded in 2021 by Abigail Gaines, Charity Manager of Friends of Rowntree Park and Director of The Tiny Roar CIC. The project was inspired by the national Make Space for Girls campaign, and has since developed into a locally led initiative focused on real change in York.

The work centres on two key areas:

Co-creating better spaces

Working directly with girls to shape park areas that reflect what they actually want and need.

Creating opportunities to take part

Running regular events and activities that build confidence, encourage creativity and support girls to feel comfortable using public space.

More about the Make Space York project

In addition to the June Festival of events, the Make Space project:

- Has helped create a new area in Rowntree Park with equipment girls asked for
- Runs other events through the year
- Continues to engage with York girls
- Supports and works with other groups and organisations on similar projects both in York and elsewhere.

Co Creating an area in Rowntree Park with teenage girls

In May 2024, a new and vibrant area opened in Rowntree Park - it was co-created with local girls. The space was shaped by girls' ideas gathered through engagement sessions over the last few years.

Through a range of patch work grant funding, we managed to get the first few pieces of equipment for the area, outlined below. We are thrilled that in 2026 that phase 2 of the area is taking place and more equipment added, due to some grant funding.

The 'Teenage Zone' co created with teenage girls

Phase 1 - May 2024

A basket swing – encouraging conversation, connection, and fun in a relaxed way.

A climbing and seating structure – a place to climb, sit, perch.

A picnic bench and log stump seating – places to sit, chat, eat snacks, or just be! Seating gives the permissions to 'stay'.

Phase 2 - June 2026

More challenging climbing log clamber stack – to move, sit and perch up high

Hammocks – to sit, swing and chat with friends

Roll bars – to sit up, hang up side down or pull up on.

What was once an overlooked patch of grass has been transformed into a welcoming, inclusive hub. The feedback from teenage girls has been especially powerful – many have shared that it's a space they know they are allowed to be, to play, to hang – a space where they belong.

Everyone is invited to use the space, but keep in mind the inclusive nature with which it was designed and funded - give teenagers priority use.



Engagement in West Bank Park



Make Space York is thrilled to be supporting the Friends of West Bank Park who are interested in knowing older girls' views on the park. This has recently started with gathering views via an online survey and also some engagement sessions in the park. The views will be used to decide if further actions should be taken. The survey takes just a few minutes and can be accessed using [the link here](#) or by scanning the QR code.

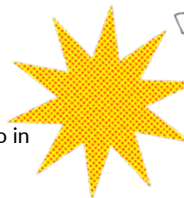
